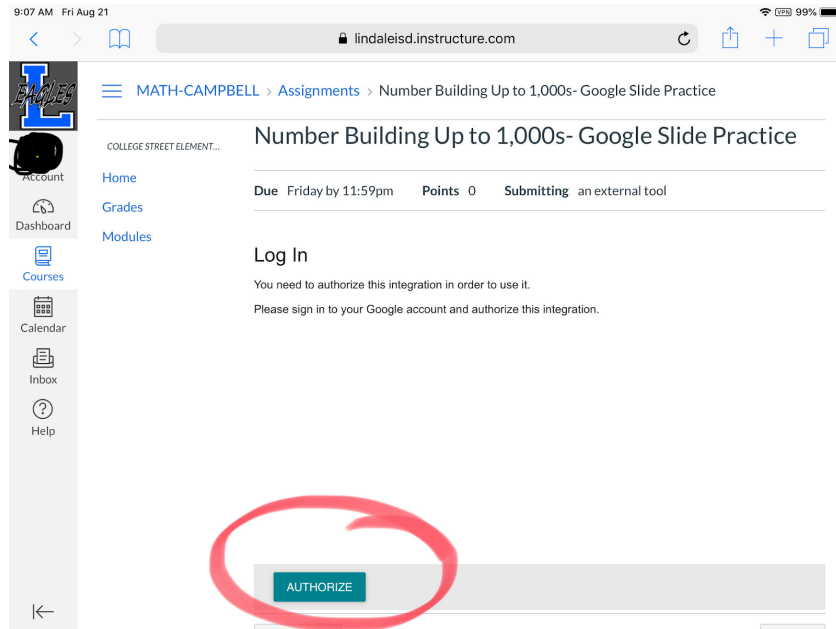
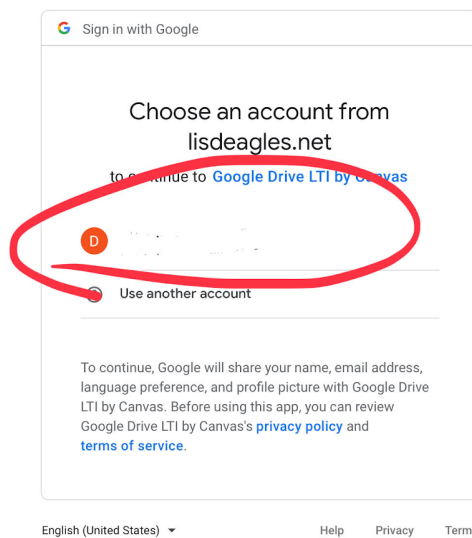
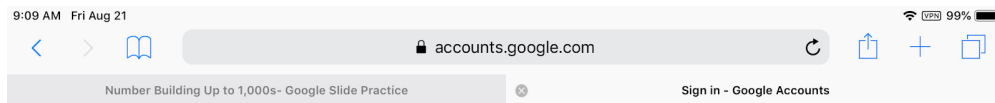


How to Submit a Google Cloud Assignment in Canvas

Step 1: Authorize the student Google account, if prompted to do so:



Continue to click the verify and continue buttons until you are brought back to the assignment page. (After students do that once, they should not have to do it again.)

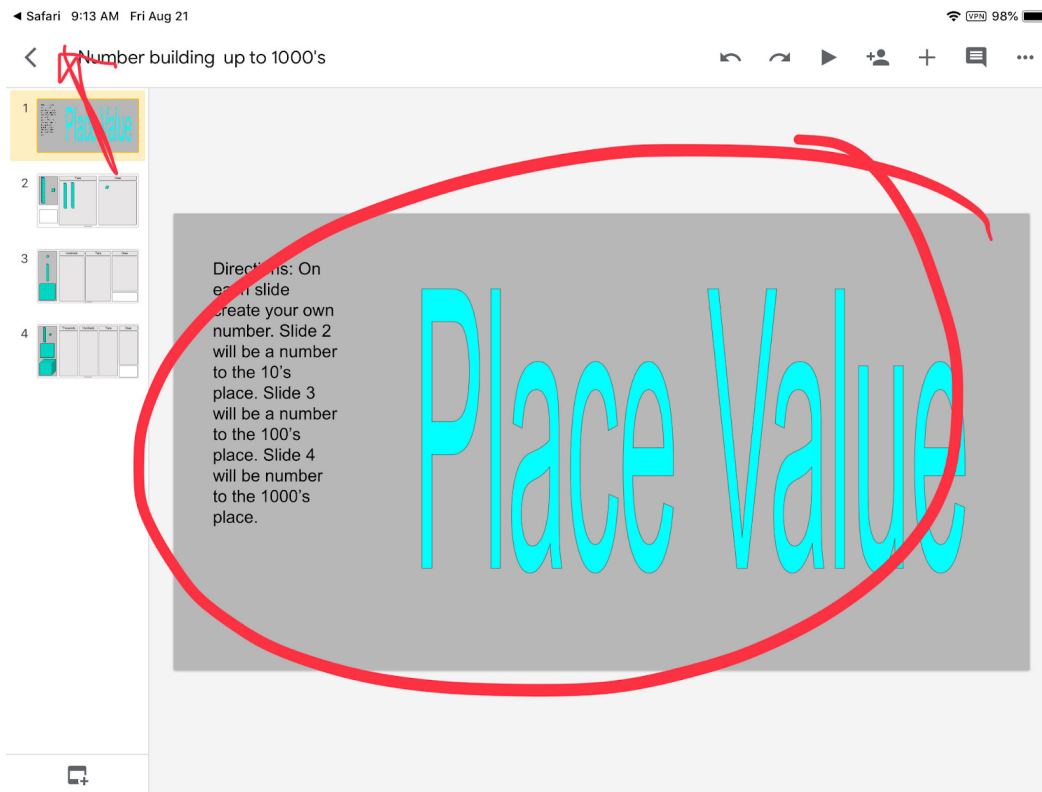
